- A certified copy of senior high school certificate or certificate of student status (for students who are studying in Senior High School or equivalent) or a certified copy of either one of the following certificates: IGCSE, GED or IB

- A certified copy of the identification card (for Thai student) or passport (for international student)

- Other supporting documents specified by each program, such as a certificate identifying special skills, English language test results taken within the preceding two years (if applicable), etc.

Remarks: 1. All required documents must be in English only (documents in any other languages must be translated into English, with an official stamp)

5.6 The faculty contacts the accepted students directly to provide further information.


7. Conditions for Graduation
