

Announcement from Prince of Songkla University Admission students in ICT-UOW program of Mathematics-Science in Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University for the Academic Year 2018

The Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University has launched an English program for Thai students who are currently studying in level 12 (Senior high school M.6) or who hold graduation certificate, students graduated from International schools and foreign students. This announcement contains details regarding the admissions requirements for Academic Year 2018. The details of admission are as follows:

1. Applicant qualifications

- 1.1 Applicants can be students who are studying currently from Thai senior high schools M.6 (Level 12 or equivalent) of Mathematics-Science program from Thai high schools or overseas high schools or English program of Thai high schools.
- 1.2 Applicants can be graduated students from Thai senior high schools of Mathematics-Science program (or equivalent) from Thai high schools or overseas high schools or English program of Thai high schools.
- 1.3 Applicants who are studying currently in senior high schools (or equivalent) attain an average score of 5 semesters (high school M.4 to M.6) and applicants who graduate (or equivalent) for 6 semesters (high school M.4 to M.6) must have the Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPAX) with no less than the requirement specified by the program (Please see the detail in the 4th topic).
- 1.4 The applicants achieve the minimum requirement in English proficiency of TOEFL scores 450 or IELTS 4.5 or other English scores (if applicable) which are approved by the Faculty of Science. The scores are valid within 2 years at the date of application submission.

2. Required documents

- 2.1 A completed application form
- 2.2 Two one-inch (3 x 4 cm) of the recent photographs taken by 6 months
- 2.3 A photocopy of transcript of academic record from high school or grade report of high school M. 4 to M.6 (for 6 semesters) in case of current student.

In case that applicant is a graduated student, the applicant has to deliver a photocopy of his/her transcript of high school M. 4 to M.6.

- 2.4 A photocopy of citizen ID card (for Thai students) or passport (for foreign students)
- 2.5 A photocopy of census registration (only for Thai citizen)
- 2.6 Application fee of 500 Baht

3. Evaluation criteria

- 3.1 Successful applicants will be evaluated by the committee. The consideration will be made according to the submitted documents specified in the topic 1.
- 3.2 The applicants will be evaluated by the committee at Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University. The qualifying examination consists of:

Interview in English for the eligible applicants. The interview will be determined based on academic knowledge of fundamental science (related to the applying program), communication skill, critical thinking, the attitude and personality of the applicants are including evaluated. In addition, the attending of scientific activities of the eligible applicants is also considered. Total score is 100. (Port Folio should be presented).

3.3 The decision will be determined by the committee based on ranking of the total score corresponding to the number of requirement from each program. The judgment from the committee appointed by the Dean of Faculty of Science is the final decision.

5. Application process

- 5.1 Applicants who meet the requirements in the topic 1. can submit his/her application packet composing of application form, all other required documents (mentioned in the topic 1) and copy of the payment proof of application fee of 500 Bath by either one of the following means:
- 5.1.1 in person (accompanied by application fee paid in cash for 500 Baht) at the Registration and Evaluation unit, Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University
 - 5.1.2 by online submission to http://www.sc.psu.ac/th/quota/.
- 5.2 Applicants must submit the application packets and application fee for 500 Baht to the Registration and Evaluation unit, Faculty of Science, (only in the official time) since today until 9 February 2018.

6. Payment methods

The payment can be completed by either one of following methods:

- 6.1 Cash payments can be made in person at the Registration and Evaluation unit on the date of application.

8. Registration fee payment

9. Password of clearing house system for right confirmation

Eligible candidates who passed the interview will obtain the password of clearing house system for making right confirmation on the 14th March 2018 from http://www.entrance.psu.ac.th website.

10. Right confirmation on clearing house system

Eligible candidates must confirm to study in Prince of Songkla University on clearing house system (round 1/2) into the Council of University Presidents of Thailand website by using the password obtained from the university as mentioned in the 9^{th} topic between 19^{th} - 22^{rd} March 2018.

Remarks:

- 1. Who does not confirm his/her right on time, it means that the candidate gives up his/her right to study in this program.
- 2. Who has confirmed his/her right in the clearing house system, that candidate will be waived (abridged) for the next admission, exception only for any candidates who get the permission from the university to waive.

11. Waiver of consent

Any eligible candidates who already confirmed to study on clearing house system but prefer to give up to study in the program, please waive from the Council of University Presidents of Thailand website by the time mentioned in the 10^{th} topic.

12. Announcements

The university will announce the roster of eligible candidates on the 29th of March 2018 on http://www.entrance.psu.ac.th website or call to the Academic Support and Development Unit at 07-4289 255-8 phone number (in the official working hours from 08.30 am to 4.30 pm).

13. Benefits for the students of co-curriculum between University of Westminster, UK and Faculty of Science, PSU

- 13.1 Students are able to enroll to study in University of Westminster, UK for one year when they are in the 4th year of their Bachelor study. Students must meet the requirement in English proficiency of TOEFL scores 550 or IELTS 5.5. The English scores will be valid within 2 years after the test date and the scores must be valid until the date of the fourth year registration.
- 13.2 Students will be received the certification of attendance for one year from University of Westminster.
- 13.3 One year credits study at University of Westminster will be transferred and recorded to PSU transcript.
- 13.4 Students will be awarded with B.Sc.degree in Information and Communication Technology of Prince of Songkla University.
- 13.5 Students who achieve the minimum requirement of one year study at University of Westminster will be eligible to apply for a Master Degree at University of Westminster without submitting English proficiency score.
- 13.6 Students receive discount 15% off from their tuition fee at University of Westminster.
- 13.7 Students can access University of Westminster Online resources for preparing to study at University of Westminster.
- 13.8 Active leaning is implemented for all classes in Information and Communication Technology Programme.

14. Graduate Requirements from Prince of Songkla University

- 14.1 Students must enroll and pass all required courses in accordance with Prince of Songkla University Regulations.
- 14.2 Students must pass a minimum English requirement specified by Prince of Songkla University.
