Subject: Admission for High-School Graduates with Foreign Languages Proficiency
for the Academic Year 2019

Prince of Songkla University Phuket Campus (PSU Phuket) is an international campus that serves as a regional education hub offering courses in English and other foreign languages; information technology; hospitality and tourism management; and environmental management for sustainable development. PSU Phuket would like to announce the admission process of 4 international programs for high school students with foreign language proficiency for Academic Year 2019 as follows:

1. Qualifications

An applicant must:

1. Be a high school student in year 2018 or a high school graduate or its equivalent,
2. Be well-mannered,
3. Be free from common infectious diseases or other serious illnesses,
4. Have not accepted a university placement seat under the Thai University Central Admission System (TCAS) for year 2019,
5. Meet all the requirements described in the following table:

3. Application Procedure

Applicants must meet all the qualifications stated above in item 1. If the applicant is found to have provided false information in the application, the university shall disqualify and terminate the application process.

3.1 Applicant must choose only one major

Provide the following supporting documents:

3.1.1 A completed application form

3.1.2 Current high school student still studying in Mathayom 6 or equivalent:

- A copy of academic transcript for 5 semesters.

3.1.3 High school graduate or equivalent:

- A copy of high school diploma or its equivalent.

3.1.4 High school equivalency certificate:

- A certified copy of IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) certificate or GED (General Educational Development) or IB (International Baccalaureate).

3.1.5 A certificate of Language Proficiency Test:

- TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) or TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or HSK (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi) or TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean).

3.1.6 A copy of identification card (for Thais) or passport (for non-Thais).

3.1.7 A portfolio prepared for the interview.

3.2 Applicants may apply through the following 4 channels:

- Applicants can access and complete the online application only during the stated application period.
- Attach all required supporting documents stated in item 3.1 above (except item 3.1.1) in one PDF file only.

3.2.2 By mail

(Round 1: December 1 - 15, 2018 by midnight, Round 5: application by mail is not accepted)

- The application form can be picked up at the Student Admissions and Registration Office on the 1st floor of Building 7 (the President’s Office Building), Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus, Kathu, Phuket during normal office hours (Monday – Friday, 8:30 am – 3:30 pm). Prepare all required supporting documents stated in item 3.1 above.

4. Selection Criteria

The University will appoint the Admissions Committee to assess and select qualified applicants as follows:

1. Applicants will be considered based on one of the following academic qualifications: current high school student still studying in Mathayom 6 (or equivalent) or IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) certificate or GED (General Educational Development) or IB (International Baccalaureate) and a certificate of Language Proficiency Test.
2. Interview score based on the following criteria:

2.1 Personality	10 points
2.2 Attitude	20 points
2.3 Communication skills	20 points
2.4 Summarizing skills	10 points
2.5 General knowledge on current events	
- Social, cultural, sports	15 points
- Economy and politics	15 points
2.6 Portfolio	10 points
Total	100 points

Remark: The interview will be conducted in Thai and/or English, Chinese, Korean (depending on the field of study).

All decisions made by the Admissions Committee are final and are not subject to further review or appeal.

6. Receipt of Confirmation Report Passcode Through TCAS

All applicants must register in the TCAS system at: <http://mytcas.com> to receive a passcode for online confirmation report.

7. Admission Confirmation (through TCAS)

Applicants who passed the interview process and are selected to study at PSU Phuket must confirm their admission through the TCAS system at: <http://mytcas.com> during the following period:

Round 1: January 30 – 31, 2019

Round 5: June 17 – 18, 2019

Otherwise, the university reserves the right to cancel the applicant's admission status. Selected applicants who have already confirmed admission through the TCAS system will no longer be eligible to apply in the next admission round, except for those who have received the TCAS Committee's approval for waiver.

8. Admission Cancellation

In case the applicants have already confirmed admission in the TCAS system but would like to cancel the admission acceptance, the applicants can proceed with the cancellation process within the specified period.

9. Announcement for Final Admission Results

The university will announce the list of successful applicants through www.entrance.psu.ac.th on:

Round 1: February 7, 2019

Round 5: June 21, 2019

10. Conditions for Admission

High school students who are still studying in Mathayom 6 and have confirmed acceptance to study at PSU Phuket must continue studying and complete high school to be fully eligible to study at the university.

12. Conditions for Graduation
