Subject: Admission for Overseas High-School Graduates for Academic Year 2019

Prince of Songkla University Phuket Campus (PSU Phuket) would like to announce the admission process for overseas high school graduates for Academic Year 2019 as follows:

1. Qualifications

- 1.1 Overseas high-school graduate with one of the following graduation certificates:
High School Diploma or IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) or GED (General Educational Development) or IB (International Baccalaureate) or equivalent,
- 1.2 Healthy and be free from communicable diseases that can hinder your study,
- 1.3 Well-mannered,
- 1.4 Specific qualifications required by each faculty or program as follows:

3. Application Procedure

3.1 Applicants can choose only one major

3.2 Provide the following supporting documents:

3.2.1 A completed application form

3.2.2 A certified copy of high school diploma or equivalent from overseas high school and transcript of record or one of the following high school equivalency certificates: IGCSE or GED or IB

3.2.3 A certificate of English language proficiency test result (TOEFL, TOEIC or IELTS)

3.2.4 A certified copy of identification card and house registration (for Thais) or passport (for non-Thais)

3.2.5 A certified copy of name/surname change certificate (if any)

3.3 Applicants may apply through the following 2 channels:

3.3.1 Via online

TCAS Round 1: December 1 - 15, 2018 by midnight

TCAS Round 5: May 30 – June 10, 2019 by midnight

3.3.2 In person

TCAS Round 1: December 1 – 14, 2018 before 03.00 pm

TCAS Round 5: May 30 – June 10, 2019 before 03.00 pm

- The application form can be picked up at the Student Admissions and Registration Office on the 1st floor of Building 7 (the President's Office Building), Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus, Kathu, Phuket during normal office hours (Monday – Friday, 8:30 am – 4:30 pm). Prepare all required supporting documents stated in item 3.2.2 – 3.2.5 above.

Remarks: 1. All required documents must be in English only. Documents in other languages must be translated into English with an official stamp.

2. All copies of documents must be certified copies.

4. Admission Criteria and Conditions

The university will appoint the Admissions Committee to assess and select qualified applicants. Applicants applying to study at the Faculty of Hospitality and Tourism will be interviewed in English. Applicants applying to study at the Faculty of International Studies will be interviewed in English or Chinese. Applicants applying to study at the Faculty of Technology and Environment will be interviewed in Thai and English. The interview score is based on the following criteria:

4.1 Personality	20 points
4.2 Attitude towards the program	20 points
4.3 General knowledge	20 points
4.4 Problem-solving skills	20 points
4.5 Language skills and readiness	20 points
Total	100 points

Applicants must receive at least 50% for each criterion and at least 60 points in total to pass the interview. All decisions made by the Admissions Committee are final and are not subject to further review or appeal.

6. Receipt of Confirmation Report Passcode Through TCAS

All applicants must register in the TCAS system at: <http://mytcas.com> to receive a passcode for online confirmation report.

7. Admission Confirmation (through TCAS)

Applicants who passed the interview process and are selected to study at PSU Phuket must confirm their admission through the TCAS system at: <http://mytcas.com> during the following period:

TCAS Round 1: January 30 – 31, 2019 TCAS Round 5: June 17 – 18, 2019

Otherwise, the university reserves the right to cancel the applicant's admission status. Selected applicants who have already confirmed admission through the TCAS system will no longer be eligible to apply in the next admission round, except for those who have received the TCAS Committee's approval for waiver.

8. Admission Cancellation

In case the applicants have already confirmed admission in the TCAS system but would like to cancel the admission acceptance, the applicants can proceed with the cancellation process within the specified period.
