



Prince of Songkla University Announcement **Admission of Overseas Senior High School Graduates, Academic Year 2019 (TCAS 2)**

In accordance with Prince of Songkla University's policies to increase international student admission opportunities, to support undergraduate internationalization, and to turn the university into an ASEAN Education Hub, the following undergraduate admission policies are in effect for academic year 2019

1. Applicant's qualifications

1.1 Eligibility

1.1.1 Thai or international students who are studying in other countries.

1.1.2 Students who are studying in or having completed senior high school or equivalent.

1.2 Specific Qualifications required by each faculty or program

2. Application Procedures

2.1 Registration in TCAS system

All applicants must register in TCAS system of Association of The Council of University Presidents of Thailand on website : <http://mytcas.com> to confirm the identity and online confirmation report to study at Prince of Songkla University .

2.2 Applicants will be able to choose one program in each admission round except those who have confirmed their online confirmation report in TCAS system of Association of The Council of University Presidents of Thailand

2.3 Check all information from faculty/college about programs and qualifications offered in this announcement.

2.4 Complete the online application on the website <http://www.entrance.psu.ac.th/foreign>

-In addition to providing information in the form, attach a two-inch photo (facing directly toward the camera, no glasses or cap)

2.5 Provide the following documents in pdf format:

- A certified copy of senior high school certificate or certificate of student status (for students who are studying in Senior High School or equivalent) or a certified copy of either one of the following certificates: IGCSE, GED or IB

- A certified copy of the identification card (for Thai student) or passport (for international student)

- Other supporting documents specified by each program, such as a certificate identifying special skills, English language test results taken within the preceding two years (if applicable), etc.

Remarks : 1. All required documents must be in English only (documents in any other languages must be translated into English, with an official stamp)

2. All documents must be certified.

Selected applicants who have already reported the confirmation in TCAS system will be disqualified from the next round admission except those who have received Association of The Council of University Presidents of Thailand's approval for waiver.

6. Waiver for studying in the university

In case the applicants accepted through TCAS system would like to cancel the acceptance of study after having reported the confirmation in the system, applicants should proceed the cancellation within the specified period.

7. Final admission results announcement

The university will announce the final name list of admitted applicants through www.entrance.psu.ac.th on 30 April 2019

8. Self Report and Registration

The accepted applicant under this channel must report and register to be a student which university will announce the schedule again through Registrar's office website of each campus. In case the student cannot report on time, the University reserves the right to cancel the acceptance of study.

9.1 Students must complete their studies and pass course assessment as specified by the relevant program in accordance with Prince of Songkla University's rules and regulations.

9.2 Students must pass a standardized English test as specified by the University.
